A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, DELEGATING TO THE DEPUTY COUNTY MANAGER/COUNTY ENGINEER OR DESIGNEE THE SIGNING AUTHORITY FOR PERMITTING ACTIVITIES RELATED TO APPROVED NASSAU COUNTY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN PROJECTS; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the value of efficiently planning, managing and delivering the Nassau County Capital Improvement Plan to the community and to the residents and visitors of Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to be proactive in the required permitting associated with the approved Nassau County Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to delegate the authority to the Deputy County Manager/County Engineer or designee to take all steps necessary to initiate and sign the required permitting documents with the St. Johns River Water Management District, Florida Department of Transportation, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, United States Army Corps of Engineers, and other partner agencies on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for projects approved in the Nassau County Capital Improvement Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:


SECTION 1. RECITALS. The above findings are true and correct are hereby incorporated by this reference.

SECTION 2. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, hereby delegates signing authority to the Deputy County Manager/County Engineer or designee to take all steps necessary to initiate and sign the required permitting documents with the St. Johns River Water Management District, Florida Department of Transportation, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, United States Army Corps of Engineers, and other partner agencies on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for projects approved in the Nassau County Capital Improvement Plan.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


