

**RESOLUTION 2024- 175**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2001-74 ESTABLISHING THE PIRATES WOOD ASSESSMENT AREA MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT AND THEREBY ABOLISHING THE PIRATES WOOD ASSESSMENT AREA MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT; AND FURTHER RESCINDING ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 125.01(1)(q), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners to “establish, and subsequently merge or abolish” municipal service taxing or benefit units for any part or all of the unincorporated county; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 14, 2001, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 2001-74 thereby establishing the Pirates Wood Assessment Area Municipal Service Benefit Unit for the funding of road improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners now finds it appropriate to abolish the Pirates Wood Assessment Area Municipal Service Benefit Unit as the services are no longer needed for the purpose of which it was established; and

**WHEREAS**, there are no funds remaining from the non-ad valorem assessments previously collected under the municipal service benefit unit; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon the foregoing, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners now finds it in the best interests and welfare of the citizens of Nassau County to abolish the Pirates Wood Assessment Area Municipal Service Benefit Unit and to direct County Staff to take all steps necessary to dissolve the municipal service benefit unit’s accounts.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

**SECTION 1. ABOLISHMENT.** The Pirates Wood Assessment Area Municipal Service Benefit Unit is hereby abolished and Resolution 2001-74 establishing the Pirates Wood Assessment Area Municipal Service Benefit Unit is hereby rescinded.


**SECTION 2. UNIT FUNDS AND ACCOUNTS.** There are no funds remaining from the non-ad valorem assessments collected under the municipal service benefit unit and County Staff is hereby directed to take all steps necessary to dissolve the municipal service benefit unit’s accounts.

**SECTION 3. CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS.** All Resolutions in conflict are hereby rescinded.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.




