CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into the 18th day of
august, 19 <u>81</u> , by and between: <u>Todd</u>
Construction Company with its principal place of
business atFolkston, Georgia
hereinafter called CONTRACTOR, and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-
SIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, hereinafter called OWNER:

WITNESSETH:

That the contractor, for the consideration hereinafter fully set out, hereby agrees with the owner as follows:

1. That the contractor shall furnish and perform all work, labor and equipment to complete the erection of a bridge known as the <u>Hill Road Bridge</u> in Nassau County, Florida, being located on that certain County road commonly known as <u>Hill Road</u> in strict accordance with the plans, drawings and specifications, and all addenda if any, which plans, drawings and specifications, bid proposals and contract documents, are made a part of this agreement as completely as if set forth herein. Copies of said plans, specifications and bid proposals are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. The owner shall furnish all bridge material for bridge erection to be delivered at the job site to a stock pile located at a convenient place in the near proximity of said construction site.

All artifacts, treasure trove or materials related hereto found by said contractor through his efforts or those of his subcontractors or agents shall be the property of the owner.

3. The contractor shall commence work to be performed under this agreement within twenty (20) working days of the receipt of notice to proceed given by the owner and the contractor shall fully complete all work hereunder within ninety (90) calendar days from the date of receipt of said notice to proceed.

4. The owner hereby agrees to pay to the contractor for the faithful performance of this agreement, subject to additions and deductions as duly authorized by the owner, in lawful money of

the United States of America, as follows: <u>The sum of eleven thousand</u> nine hundred ninety four and no/100 (\$11,994.00)

being the amount of the contractor's base bid for all work called for in said plans and specifications, which payment shall be made in full after all work has been performed strictly in accordance with this agreement and said work has been accepted by the owner.

Upon submission by the contractor of evidence satisfactory to the owner that all payrolls, bills and other costs incurred by the contractor in connection with the construction of the work have been paid in full, final payment on account of this agreement shall be made within ten (10) days after the completion by the contractor of all work covered by this agreement and the acceptance of such work by the owner.

5. If any work or any part thereof is not completed within the time agreed upon in this agreement or any extension thereof, the contractor shall be liable to the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners in the amount of \$100. per day for each and every calendar day the completion of the work is delayed beyond the time provided in this agreement. The Nassau County Board of County Commissioners shall have the right to deduct from and retain out of monies which may be due or which may become due and payable to the contractor, any sums due as liquidated damages resulting from delay.

6. It is further mutually agreed between the parties hereto that if, at any time after the execution of this agreement and the surety bond attached for its faithful performance, the owner shall deem the surety of sureties upon such bond to be unsatisfactory, or if, for any reason, such bond ceases to be adequate to cover the performance of the work, the contractor shall, at its expense, within five (5) days after the receipt of notice from the owner so to do, furnish an additional bond or bonds in such form and amount, and with such surety or sureties as shall be satisfactory to the owner. In such event no further payment to the contractor shall be deemed to be due under this agreement until such new or additional surety for the faithful performance of the work shall be furnished in manner and form satisfactory to the owner.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties hereto have executed this agreement on the day and date first above written in two counterparts, each of which shall, without proof or accounting for the other counterpart, be deemed an original contract.

CONSTRUCTION AND ASSEMBLING OF A PREFABRICATED BRIDGE

The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida invites sealed bids for the erection and installation of a bridge for which timber material has been furnished by Southeast Timber Bridge Co.

All bridge materials are to be furnished and delivered to the job site by County forces.

Bridge shall be constructed and completed to meet specifications within 90 days from the date of Notice to Proceed.

Bridge completed as per specifications bid price

Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and insurance for the construction of a timber bridge.

Bids shall be firm for a period of not less than thirty days.

Erection procedures shall be according to the manufacturer's specifications and Florida Department of Transportation specifications where applicable.

Contractor shall be responsible for bridge layout. Finish deck elevation shall be established by the County Engineer and be the contractor's responsibility to construct the bridge to that elevation.

The County shall remove the existing structure and construct fill as required.

Bid Bond or Cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) must accompany each and every bid.

Acceptable surety bond in the sum at least equal to the amount of contract awarded shall be furnished.

All bidders are required to fill out CERTIFICATION FOR EQUAL OPPORTUNITY EMPLOYER, attachment "B".

Excavation of channel under bridge shall be required as a part of this contract and shall be under the direction of the County Engineer. The material removed shall be bid at a separate unit cost. Excavation costs shall be unit cost per cubic yard of excavation. All material to be stored on the immediate job site.
