CONSTRUCTION & MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT AMENDMENT

THIS CONSTRUCTION & MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT AMENDMENT ("Amendment") is made and entered into by and between the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("Department") and the Nassau County, Florida ("Agency").

-RECITALS-

- 1. The terms and provisions set forth in this Amendment are incorporated into and made part of that certain Construction and Maintenance Agreement for Financial Project Number 442169-3-52-01 ("Original Agreement") entered and executed by and between the parties October 25, 2018, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A"; and
- 2. This Amendment shall be merged into and made part of the Contract and both documents shall be collectively referred to as the ("Agreement"); and
- 3. The Original Agreement defined the term Improvement as bridge repair, including milling and resurfacing, and the removal and installation of guardrail and wing walls; and
- 4. The sole purpose of this Amendment is to include the temporary closure of the Bridge and the detour of vehicular and pedestrian traffic ("Bridge Detour") during construction of the Improvement; and
- 5. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the Original Agreement and this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall control; and
 - 6. All other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals and mutual covenants and conditions in this Amendment, the parties, intending to be legally bound, acknowledge, covenant and agree as follows:

1. RECITALS

The above recitals and attached exhibits are specifically incorporated by reference and made part of this Amendment.

2. BRIDGE DETOUR

The Department and the Agency agree that the Original Agreement will be amended and the following language providing for a Bridge Detour during the construction of the Improvement is incorporated as follows:

A. During construction of the Improvement, the Department must temporarily close access to the Bridge and re-route vehicular traffic throughout the duration of construction of the Improvement, the Bridge Detour is more particularly shown in **Exhibit "B"**; and

CONSTRUCTION & MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

THIS CONSTRUCTION & MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("Department") and Nassau County Fiorida ('Agency')

RECITALS-

- The term "Property" shall refur to certain real property located in the Nassau County, I londs, owned by the Agency and more particularly described bridge repair of CR 121 over Deep Creek (Bridge Number 740050), as shows in attached Exhibit "A"; and
- The term "Improvement" inwans and shall refer to bridge repair including mill and resurfacing and the removal and lostalitation of guardrail and wing walks, as more particularly shown in attached Exhibit "B", and
- The Department shall fund construction of the Improvement, which is wholly contingent upon appropriation of funds to the Department, and
 - The Department shall construct the Improvement on the Property, and
- 5. A date for the commencement of construction of the Improvement has not been established and
- Prior to commencement of any construction by the Department, the Agency shall ensure that the Property is free and clear of any and all encroachments; and
- Upon completion of the construction, the Agency shall own, operate, maintain and repair the improvement at its sole cost and expense; and
- 8. By Resolution 2018–92 dated 9/10/18 the Agency authorized its representative to execute and enter this Agrooment on behalf of the Agency, see Exhibit "C"

NOW THEREFORE with full knowledge and understanding of the laws governing the subject matter of this Agreement, and in consideration of the above recitals and the mutual coverants and conditions contained in this Agreement, the parties, intending to be legally bound, acknowledge and agree as follows:

1. RECITALS AND EXHIBITS
The above recitals and attached Exhibits are specifically incorporated by reference and made part of this Agreement.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of this Agreement shall be the date the last of the parties to be charged executes the Agreement.

This Agreement authorizes the Department to access the Property for the limited purpose of performing this Agreement.

The initial term of this Agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year, commencing on the Effective Date and concluding on the anniversary of the Effective Date. This Agreement shall automatically renew for successive and continuing like one (1) year terms unless terminated by the Dopartment in willing.

The Agency (A) shall utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the Agency during the term of the contract; and (B)

shall expressly require any subcontractors performing work or providing services pursuant to the state contract to likewise utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the subcontractor during the contract term.

6. COMPLIANCE

The Agency shall perform the Agreement in a good and workmankse manner, with reasonable card in accordance with the forms and provisions of this Agreement and all applicable federal, state, local, administrative, regulatory sofety and environmental laws, codes, rules, regulations policies, procedures guidelines, standards specifications and permits as the same may be constituted and amended from time to time, including, without limitation, those of the Department, Water Management District with requisite jurisdiction. Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Invitedmental Protection Agency, Army Corps of Engineers, United States Coast Quart and local governmental antities ("Governmental Law").

7. PERMITS

In the performance of the Agreement the Agency may be required to obtain one or more Department permits which may include copies of the Agreement as an exhibit. Notwithstanding the inclusion or recorporation of the Agreement as part of any such Department permits, the Agreement shall remain separate and apart from such permits and shall not be merged into the sumulablent the prior written express consent of the Department. Should any term or provision of the Agreement conflict with any term, provision or requirement of any Department permit, the terms and provisions of the Agreement shall control unless specifically noted otherwise in any such Department permit. For purposes of this Agreement, the form "permit" shall also include the Department's Construction Agreement which may be required for permanent improvements installed within the Department's right-of-way.

8. PROJECT MANAGEMENT

A The Department shall manage the Project for the design and construction of the improvement and perform such activities as the Department deems necessary and appropriate to complete the Project for the improvement including without limitation, seeking and obtaining approval and participation by one or more federal agencies, design of the improvement acquisition of right-of-way, construction of the improvement, and any other activities to facilitate satisfactory completion of the improvement. The Department shall commence construction of the improvement at its convenience after the appropriation of sufficient funds.

B. Prior to commendement of construction and at their sole cost and expense, the Agency shall ensure that the Property is free and clear of any and all encroachments that may impede or in any way interfere with the Departments construction of the Improvement.

9. UTILITIES

The Agency shall be responsible for locating, removing and relocating utilities, both aerial and underground if required for the Agency to perform this Agreement. The Agency shall ensure all utility locations are accurately documented on the construction Plans and Specifications, including the final as-built plans. All utility conflicts shall be resolved by the Agency directly with the approache utility.

10. OPERATION, MAINTENANCE & REPAIR

A The Agency shall operate, maintain, and repair the Improvement at its sole cost and expense, in a good and workmanlike manner, with reasonable care, in accordance with the terms and provisions of this Agreement including applicable Governmental Law.

B. The Agency agrees that it will be solely responsible for the operation, maintenance and repair of the Improvement. Should the Agency fail to operate, maintain and repair the Improvement in accordance with the terms and provisions of this Agreement and applicable Governmental Law, and the Department be required to perform such operation, maintenance or repair pursuant to the Inspection of Federal-Ard Projects Order Local, Jurisdiction, Topic No. 850-965-961, under the authority of Title 23, Section 116, U.S. Code, the Agency agrees that it shall be fully responsible to the Department for repayment of any funds expended by the Department for the operation, maintenance, or repair of the Improvement. The Department shall invoice the Agency for any operation, maintenance, or repair expenses charged to the Department, and the Agency shall pay such invoices in accordance with the Payment section of this Agreement. Nothing in this Agreement shall relieve the Agency of its financial obligations to the Department should this occur.

The Department shall transfer all transferable warranties concerning construction of the Improvement to the Agency. The assignment shall be evidenced by a separate written agreement agreed by the parties and shall be subject to applicable Governmental Law and the construction agreement entered between the Department and its contractor.

12. EMINENT DOMAIN AND DAMAGES

Under no dicturnatances shall the Department's exercise of any right provided in this Agricement create any right, title, interest or estate entitling the Agency to full and just compensation from the Department either through inverse condemnation or eminent domain laws or any similar laws regarding the taking of property for public purposes. The Agency forever waives and relinquishes all legal rights and monetary claims which it has, or which may arise in the future for compensation or damages, including, without mutation, special damages severance damages removal costs and loss of business profits resulting in any manner from the Department's exercise of any right provided in this Agreement. This waiver and relinquishment specifically includes all damages flowing from adjacent properties owned, leased or otherwise controlled by the Agency, as a result of the Department's exercise of any right provided in this Agreement.

13. PAYMENT

All Department process submitted for payment pursuant to the terms and provisions of this Agroement are due and payable within firity (30) days of the date of the invoice ("Due Date"). Any portion of an invoice not received by the Department by the Due Date shall immediately thereafter begin accruing interest at a rate of interest established pursuant to \$55.03. Florida Statutes until paid in full (past due principal and accrued interest shall be collectively referred to as "Past Due Sums")

14. INDEMNIFICATION

Nothing therein contained shall prevent the making of contracts for portions accounding 1 year, but any contract so made shall be executery only for the value of the services to be rendered or agreed to object for in succoolding Fiscal years, and this paragraph shall be incorporated vertration in all contracts of the department which are for an amount in excess of \$25,000 and which have a term for a period of more than 1 year.




EXHIBIT "A" (LOCATION MAP)
