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FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this 9th day of <u>January</u>. 2023 by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "Board", and the NASSAU COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BOARD, INC.

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc., has been formed to further economic development in Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires successful economic development within Nassau County that will leverage Nassau County's competitive market position by attracting new business and fostering business expansion; and

WHEREAS, the Board is desirous of entering into a funding agreement with the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. in order to further the economic efforts in Nassau County.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. shall forge a public/private partnership between the County Political Subdivision(s) and the local business community.
- 2. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc., shall be responsible for economic development in the County. This responsibility includes serving as the point of contact and intake for applicants seeking to utilize the local economic development grant incentive program pursuant to Nassau County Ordinance 2015-02, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment "A". However, the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. does not have authority to negotiate any local incentive/grant beyond that established in Ordinance 2015-02, or, any other incentive/grant that requires the payment of monies by the County or that utilizes County funds/assets to warranty an incentive/grant without first obtaining written approval from the County.
- 3. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc., shall actively seek to generate new industry and Jobs.
- The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc., shall assist new business relocation to the County.

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- 5. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc., shall develop a multi-faceted funding program for the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. and its economic development activity. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. shall, by May 1st annually, provide the County Manager with a report outlining the funding program and economic development activity.
- 6. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc., shall communicate/explain to the community at large the concept of planned economic development as a necessity to the maintenance of the present quality of life for the residents of Nassau County. This must include every constituency in the County. There must be an understanding of what constitutes economic development, its many benefits, and what the future holds without it.
- 7. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc., shall develop a comprehensive program to assist, encourage, facilitate, and assist existing businesses to continue to operate or to expand their operations, thus leading to enhanced employment opportunities.
- 8. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. shall annually develop a marketing outreach plan that will identify, attract, and recruit new businesses and industries to Nassau County and provide a copy to the County Manager.
- 9. For the sum of one-hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000), which shall be paid in quarterly installments, during the month of December, February, May and August, the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. agrees to provide the services outlined in the Agreement for the benefit of the residents of Nassau County, Florida. Appropriations necessary for the funding of this Agreement beyond Fiscal Year 2022/2023 shall be subject to the budget and appropriation by the County during the regular budget process.
- 10. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. shall submit simultaneously to the County Manager and the Clerk an annual accounting acceptable to the Clerk on or before May 1st of each Fiscal Year in which the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. receives funding from the County. Additionally, the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. shall make its books available for inspection by a designee of the County upon reasonable notice. Failure of the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. to provide the annual accounting records by the time specified shall result in the revocation of granting of further funds and reimbursement of funds distributed during the year for which no report was submitted.

- 11. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc., shall make appearances before the Board at the Board's request and may any reports deemed necessary by both boards.
- 12. The Board shall have the right to appoint one member to serve on the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc.
- 13. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. will not perform any of the services set forth herein for any other association, governmental body or entity.
- 14. The Executive Director of the Economic Development Board shall not perform any services for any other association, governmental body or entity, unless that association, governmental body, or entity is charged for his or her services and further that the Executive Director shall not perform any other services if the performance of those services in any way causes him or her not to devote the majority of time to economic development in Nassau County.
- 15. The Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc. shall comply with the provisions of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes, Section 286.011, Florida Statutes, except those records, pursuant to Section 288.075, Florida Statutes, that are deemed confidential and exempt from Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes.
- 16. The term of this Agreement shall commence on October 1, 2022 and terminate on September 30, 2023. This Agreement may be amended in writing from time to time by mutual written consent of the parties.
- 17. All facilities, programs and services shall be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs, and services that are compliant with both the Florida Accessibility Code and the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of this Agreement and may result in termination of this Agreement.
- 18. A breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement may cause the Board to terminate this Agreement. Further, the Board may terminate this Agreement, for other than a breach, by providing thirty (30) days written notice to the Nassau County Economic Development Board, Inc.
