#### FIRE STATION / VEHICLE STORAGE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made and entered into this 10th day of April

2023, by and between the Town of Callahan, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "Town," and Nassau County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the "County."

WHEREAS, the Town owns a fire station located at 542300 US Highway One, Callahan, FL 32011 ("Fire Station");

WHEREAS, the County currently has an operational need for protected bay area space to house an Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") vehicle and an Advanced Life Support ("ALS") engine;

WHEREAS, the County also has a need for storage space and for daily living space for personnel assigned to the above emergency vehicles.

WHEREAS, the Town is able to provide at the Fire Station the bay area space, storage space, and daily living space that the County requires;

WHEREAS, the County is willing to pay the Town on a regular basis for such space; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest and to the mutual benefit of both the citizens of the Town and the citizens of the surrounding County areas to enter into this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, and other good and valuable considerations, the Town and the County do hereby agree to the following:

- 1. <u>PURPOSE AND SCOPE</u>. This Agreement provides, through the cooperation of the Town and the County, for efficient and equitable emergency medical services for the Town of Callahan and surrounding areas.
- 2. TERM AND EFFECTIVE DATE. The initial term of this Agreement shall be October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2024. This Agreement shall automatically renew every five (5) years unless it is terminated in accordance with Section 7.
- 3. SPACE TO BE PROVIDED. During the term of this Agreement, the Town will make available to the County, at the Fire Station, (a) two protected bay areas for the housing of an EMS vehicle and an ALS engine, and the back portion of bay one for workout equipment and gear storage. (b) daily living space on the second floor of the Fire Station for the use of County personnel assigned to the County's emergency vehicle. The County additionally may utilize the 1<sup>st</sup>, floor common area for any training/or fire department functions. (Common area to include the restrooms, laundry, and kitchen area and decontamination room), providing Town is notified as much in advance as possible but not less than 48 hrs., to accommodate other uses. When the 1<sup>st</sup> floor area is utilized, County will be responsible for maintaining/cleaning. In the event another bay becomes available Town will give first right to County.
- 4. MAINTENANCE & UPKEEP. Except as provided in paragraph 6 of this Agreement, the Town is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the Fire Station's building envelope and the HVAC system. At its own expense, the County shall promptly and diligently maintain and keep up the two

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bay areas, the daily living space, and storage space provided pursuant to this Agreement. The payment described in Section 5 shall not include these costs, which shall be separate and borne by the County alone.

- 5. <u>COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT</u>. In return for the space provided pursuant to this Agreement, the County shall pay to the Town the sum of TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,200) per month. The County shall pay the Town this amount in advance of the first day of each month that this Agreement is in effect.
- 6. <u>INDEMNITY</u>. The County and the Town do not assume any liability for the acts, omissions, and negligence of the other. The County is responsible for any damage that occurs to the Fire Station if said damage is attributable to any act, omission, or negligence of County personnel.
- 7. <u>TERMINATION</u>. Either party may terminate this Agreement by delivering written notice to the other party, by certified mail, return receipt requested, at least ninety (90) days prior to the date of termination. Termination shall take effect on the date specified in the written notice.


