Description of Changes:

A. Underrun plan quantity for contract Pay Item 570-1-13 (Performance Turf, Sod and Soil – Shoulder Treatment Index 570-010) by 3,975-SY from 29,066-SY to 25,091-SY.

- B. Underrun plan quantity for contract Pay Item 706-1-3 (Raised Pavement Marker, Type B) by 352 EA from 1,861 EA to 1,509 EA.
- C. Underrun plan quantity for contract Pay Item 711-16-102 (Thermoplastic, Standard-Other Surfaces, White, Solld, 8") by 0.02 GM from 0.02 GM to 0.00 GM.
- D. Overrun plan quantity for contract Pay Item 711-16-101 (Thermoplastic, Standard-Other Surfaces, White, Solid, 6") by 0.02 GM from 2.00 GM to 2.20 GM.

Justification for Changes:

- A. Nassau County and contractor agreed to eliminate 10,221-LF of 3.5-ft wide shoulder treatment work for Pay Item 570-1-13 (Performance Turf, Sod and Soil Shoulder Treatment Index 570-010) from Station 127+20 to Station 171+77. As a result of observed and existing site conditions, shoulder treatment was not needed within the limits identified.
- B. Contractor's sequence of milling and resurfacing from Station 127+20 (Bay Rd) to Station 171+00 (CSX RR Crossing) and from Station 208+62 to Station 541+42 (Middle Rd) resulted in 352 fewer Pay Item 706-1-3 (Raised Pavement Marker, Type B) (RPM) being required for project completion.
- C. Subcontractor mistakenly applied 0.02 GM of contract Pay Item 711-16-101 (Thermoplastic, Standard-Other Surfaces, White, Solid, 6") from Station 135+46 to Station 135+84 and from Station 135+91 to Station 136+24 instead of 0.02 GM of contract Pay Item 711-16-102 (Thermoplastic, Standard-Other Surfaces, White, Solid, 8") per contract plan sheet S-3 (Signing and Pavement Markings). Nassau County agreed to leave the 6" thermoplastic pavement marking in place.
- D. Subcontractor applied 0.02 GM of contract Pay Item 711-16-101 (Thermoplastic, Standard-Other Surfaces, White, Solid, 6") from Station 135+46 to Station 135+84 and from Station 135+91 to Station 136+24 instead of 0.02 GM of contract Pay Item 711-16-102 (Thermoplastic, Standard-Other Surfaces, White, Solid, 8") per contract plan sheet S-3 (Signing and Pavement Markings). Nassau County agreed to leave the 6" thermoplastic pavement marking in place.

Change Order #3 Entitlement Analysis

Description of Underrun Quantities Requested: An underrun of 3,975-SY of performance turf shoulder treatment due to existing field conditions conflicting with the roadway plans. An underrun of 352-EA of raised pavement markers (RPM) to contractor's means and methods resulted in fewer RPM being needed to complete the project. An underrun of 0.02-GM of 8" wide, solid white thermoplastic pavement marking which was not placed on the project.

Description of Overrun Quantity Requested: An overrun of 0.02-GM of 6" wide, solid white thermoplastic pavement marking applied instead of of 8" wide, solid white thermoplastic pavement marking.

Entitlement Analysis for Additional Contract Cost Reduction: On 7/2S/23, a field meeting was held to discuss the planned shoulder treatment for CR 108 between Bay Road and US highway 1 in Hilliard, FL. Representatives from Hubbard Construction Company, Nassau County, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Two, and DRMP established that an excessive amount of existing material would need to be removed from the shoulder areas along CR 108 from Station 127+20 (Bay Road) to Station 171+77 (US Highway 1) in order to achieve the desired outcome of applying work entailed by Pay Item 570-1-13 (Performance Turf, Sod and Soil – Shoulder Treatment Index S70-010). Removal of the excess material from the shoulder areas was not within the original scope of the project, therefore it was agreed that the contractor would not perform the shoulder treatment between those stations. Nassau County agreed to allow for the mistakenly applied 6" thermoplastic pavement marking to remain in place in lieu of the 8" planned pavement marking.

Engineer's Concurrence: To avoid the unplanned removal of a large quantity of material and regrading of the existing shoulder areas along CR 108 between Bay Road and US highway 1, it was necessary to reduce the plan quantity for Pay Item 570-1-13 (Performance Turf, Sod and Soil – Shoulder Treatment index 570-010) by 3,975-SY. DRMP agrees that the underrun of shoulder treatment quantity is acceptable and meets the intent of the project.
