NONPROFIT GRANT FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR NASSAU COUNCIL OF ARTS AND CULTURE, INC. FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025

THIS NONPROFIT GRANT FUNDING AGREEMENT (hereinafter "Agreement") is entered into by and between the BOARD OF COUTNY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and NASSAU COUNCIL OF ARTS AND CULTURE, INC., located at 2032 VILLAGE LANE

FERNANDINA BEACH, FL 32034, hereinafter referred to as "COUNCIL".

WHEREAS, COUNCIL supplies appreciation, awareness, and cultural opportunities of all the arts in the community by promoting and enhancing the arts to Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, COUNCIL partners with other arts and culture organizations within Nassau County and COUNTY desires to support COUNCIL'S efforts; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above, COUNTY is desirous of entering into a Funding Agreement with COUNCIL, pursuant to the Nassau County Board of County Commissioner's Nonprofit Grant Funding Policy, as amended, in order to fund said services as set forth more particularly below.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

SECTION 1. RECITALS.

1.1 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein, in their entirety, by this reference.

SECTION 2. SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY COUNCIL.

Page 1 of 10

2.1 COUNCIL agrees to provide the following services pursuant to the terms of this Agreement to wit: provide support to local arts organizations to improve the appreciation, awareness and cultural opportunities of all the arts in the community by promoting and enhancing the arts (hereinafter "Services").

SECTION 3. FUNDING AMOUNT.

3.1 For the Services outlined in Section 2. of this Agreement, **COUNTY** shall pay **COUNCIL** the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$7,000.00) (hereinafter "Funding Amount").

3.2 COUNCIL shall use and allocate the Funding Amount solely for the Services as outlined in Section 2. of this Agreement.

3.3 COUNTY's performance and obligation under this Agreement is contingent upon an annual appropriation by the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners for subsequent fiscal years and is subject to termination based on lack of funding.

SECTION 4. TERM OF AGREEMENT.

4.1 The term of this Agreement shall commence on March 1, 2025 and terminate on February 28, 2026, unless terminated pursuant to Section 5 hereinbelow.

SECTION 5. TERMINATION.

5.1 If **COUNCIL** fails to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement, and if such default remains uncured for more than fifteen (15) days after written notice was provided by **COUNTY**, then **COUNTY** may, without prejudice to any right or remedy **COUNTY** may have, terminate this Agreement and cessation of payment.

5.2 Either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to the

other party, subject to completion of all previous and outstanding billings.

SECTION 6. ANNUAL ACCOUNTING BY RECIPIENT.

6.1 COUNCIL shall submit simultaneously to the County Manager and the Nassau County Clerk of Courts (hereinafter "Clerk") an annual accounting record acceptable to the Clerk on or before September 30 of each fiscal year in which **COUNCIL** received funding from **COUNTY**.

6.2 COUNCIL shall make its books available for inspection by a designee of **COUNTY** upon reasonable notice. Failure of **COUNCIL** to provide the annual accounting record by the time specified shall result in the revocation of granting of further funds and reimbursement of funds distributed during the year for which no report was submitted.

SECTION 7. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR.

7.1 In performing its obligation under this Agreement, **COUNCIL** shall be at all times acting in the capacity of an independent contractor and not as an officer, employee or agent of **COUNTY**.

SECTION 8. FLORIDA PUBLIC RECORDS LAW.

8.1 COUNTY is a public agency subject to Chapter 119, Florida Statutes.

8.2 IF COUNCIL HAS **QUESTIONS** THE REGARDING APPLICATION OF CHAPTER 119, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO **COUNCIL TO PROVIDE PUBLIC RECORDS RELATING TO THIS** CONTACT **CUSTODIAN** AGREEMENT, THE OF PUBLIC AT RECORDS (904) 530-6090,

8.3 Under this Agreement, to the extent that **COUNCIL** is providing Services to **COUNTY**, and pursuant to Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes, **COUNCIL** shall:

a. Keep and maintain public records required by **COUNTY** to provide Services.

b. Upon request from **COUNTY**'s custodian of public records, provide **COUNTY** with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in this chapter or as otherwise provided by law.

c. Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the Agreement term and following completion of the Agreement if **COUNCIL** does not transfer the records to **COUNTY**.

d. Upon completion of the Agreement, transfer, at no cost, to **COUNTY** all public records in possession of **COUNCIL** or keep and maintain public records required by **COUNTY** to perform the service. If **COUNCIL** transfers all public records to **COUNTY** upon completion of the Agreement, **COUNCIL** shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If **COUNCIL** keeps and maintains public records upon completion of the Agreement, **COUNCIL** shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically shall be provided to **COUNTY**, upon request from **COUNTY**'s custodian of public records, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of **COUNTY**.

8.4 A request to inspect or copy public records relating to **COUNTY**'s Agreement shall be made directly to **COUNTY**. If **COUNTY** does not possess the requested records, **COUNTY** shall immediately notify **COUNCIL** of the request, and **COUNCIL** shall provide the records to the public agency or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time.

8.5 If **COUNCIL** does not comply with **COUNTY**'s request for records, **COUNTY** shall enforce the Agreement provisions in accordance with the Agreement.

8.6 If **COUNCIL** fails to provide the public records to **COUNTY** within a reasonable time, **COUNCIL** may be subject to penalties under Section 119.10, Florida Statutes.

8.7 If a civil action is filed against **COUNCIL** to compel production of public records relating to the Agreement, the Court shall assess and award against **COUNCIL** the reasonable costs of enforcement, including reasonable attorney fees if:

(a) The Court determines that **COUNCIL** unlawfully refused to comply with the public records request within a reasonable time; and

(b) At least eight (8) business days before filing the action, the plaintiff provided written notice of the public records request, including a statement that **COUNCIL** has not complied with the request, to **COUNTY** and to **COUNCIL**.

8.8 A notice complies with this Section, if it is sent to **COUNTY**'s custodian of public records and to **COUNCIL** at **COUNCIL** address listed on its Agreement with **COUNTY**

or to **COUNCIL** registered agent. Such notices shall be sent to the address listed above for each party.

8.9 If COUNCIL complies with a public records request within eight (8) business days

after the notice is sent, COUNCIL is not liable for the reasonable costs of enforcement.

SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT.

9.1 All facilities, programs and services shall be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs, and services that are compliant with both the Florida Accessibility Code and the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of the Agreement and may result in termination of this Agreement.

<u>SECTION 10. GOVERNING LAW, VENUE AND COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS AND</u> <u>COUNTY NONPROFIT GRANT FUNDING POLICY.</u>

10.1 This Agreement shall be deemed to have been executed and entered into within the State of Florida and any dispute arising hereunder, shall be governed, interpreted and construed according to the laws of the State of Florida, the Ordinances of Nassau County, and any applicable federal statutes, rules and regulations. Any and all litigation arising under this Agreement shall be brought in Nassau County, Florida, and any trial shall be non-jury. Any mediation, pursuant to litigation, shall occur in Nassau County, Florida.

10.2 COUNCIL shall comply with any applicable regulatory requirements including federal, state, and local laws, rules, regulations codes, orders, criteria and standards and the Nassau County Board of County Commissioner's Nonprofit Grant Funding Policy, as amended.

SECTION 11. INDEMNIFICATION.

Page 6 of 10

11.1 COUNCIL shall indemnify and hold harmless **COUNTY** and its officers and employees from any and all damages, losses, liabilities, and costs, including but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees, to the extent caused by the negligence, recklessness, or intentionally wrongful conduct of **COUNCIL** and other persons employed or utilized by **COUNCIL** in the performance of the Agreement.

SECTION 12. NOTICES.

12.1 All notices, demands, requests for approvals or other communications given by the parties to another in connection with this Agreement shall be in writing, and shall be sent by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, or overnight delivery service (such as federal express), or courier service or by hand delivery to the office of each party indicated below:

SECTION 13. ADVERTISING.

13.1 COUNCIL shall not publicly disseminate any information concerning this Agreement

without prior written approval from **COUNTY**, including but not limited to, mentioning the Agreement in a press release or other promotional material, identifying **COUNTY** as a reference, or otherwise linking **COUNCIL's** name and either description of this Agreement or the name of **COUNTY** in any material published, either in print or electronically, to any entity that is not a party this Agreement, except potential or actual authorized distributors, dealers, resellers, or service representative.

SECTION 14. AMENDMENTS.

14.1 This Agreement may be amended only in writing by mutual consent of the parties.

SECTION 15. NO ASSIGNMENT.

15.1 COUNCIL shall not assign, sublet, convey or transfer its interest in this Agreement without the prior written consent of **COUNTY**.

SECTION 16. HUMAN TRAFFICKING AFFIDAVIT.

16.1 In accordance with Section 787.06, Florida Statutes, **COUNCIL** shall provide **COUNTY** an affidavit, on a form approved by **COUNTY**, signed by an officer or a representative of **COUNCIL** under penalty of perjury attesting that **COUNCIL** does not use coercion for labor or services as defined in Section 787.06, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 17. ENTIRE AGREEMENT, EXECUTION, SEVERABILITY AND NO WAIVER.

17.1 This Agreement, together with any attachments, constitutes the entire agreement between **COUNTY** and **COUNCIL** and supersedes all prior written or oral understandings.

17.2 This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts; each executed counterpart hereof shall be deemed an original; and all such counterparts, when taken

together, shall be deemed to constitute one and the same instrument.

17.3 In the event any part of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, that part shall be deemed severed from this Agreement and the balance of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

17.4 No release or waiver of any provision of this Agreement shall be enforceable against or binding upon a party unless in writing and executed by the releasing or waiving party. The failure of any party to insist upon specific performance of any of the agreements, terms, covenants, or conditions of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of any rights or remedies that either party may have, or a waiver of any subsequent courses of actions or claims based upon breach or default of any of such agreements, terms, covenants, and conditions.

ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, County of Nassau (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through the DocuSign system. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to this Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure (ERSD), please confirm your agreement by selecting the check-box next to 'I agree to use electronic records and signatures' before clicking 'CONTINUE' within the DocuSign system.

Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. You will have the ability to download and print documents we send to you through the DocuSign system during and immediately after the signing session and, if you elect to create a DocuSign account, you may access the documents for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. You may request delivery of such paper copies from us by following the procedure described below.

Withdrawing your consent

If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format. How you must inform us of your decision to receive future notices and disclosure in paper format and withdraw your consent to receive notices and disclosures electronically is described below.

Consequences of changing your mind

If you elect to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format, it will slow the speed at which we can complete certain steps in transactions with you and delivering services to you because we will need first to send the required notices or disclosures to you in paper format, and then wait until we receive back from you your acknowledgment of your receipt of such paper notices or disclosures. Further, you will no longer be able to use the DocuSign system to receive required notices and consents electronically from us or to sign electronically documents from us.

All notices and disclosures will be sent to you electronically

Unless you tell us otherwise in accordance with the procedures described herein, we will provide electronically to you through the DocuSign system all required notices, disclosures, authorizations, acknowledgements, and other documents that are required to be provided or made available to you during the course of our relationship with you. To reduce the chance of you inadvertently not receiving any notice or disclosure, we prefer to provide all of the required notices and disclosures to you by the same method and to the same address that you have given us. Thus, you can receive all the disclosures and notices electronically or in paper format through the paper mail delivery system. If you do not agree with this process, please let us know as described below. Please also see the paragraph immediately above that describes the consequences of your electing not to receive delivery of the notices and disclosures electronically from us.

If you created a DocuSign account, you may update it with your new email address through your account preferences.

To request paper copies from County of Nassau

To request delivery from us of paper copies of the notices and disclosures previously provided by us to you electronically, you must send us an email to bsimmons@nassaucountyfl.com and in the body of such request you must state your email address, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We will bill you for any fees at that time, if any.

To withdraw your consent with County of Nassau

To inform us that you no longer wish to receive future notices and disclosures in electronic format you may:

i. decline to sign a document from within your signing session, and on the subsequent page, select the check-box indicating you wish to withdraw your consent, or you may;

ii. send us an email to bsimmons@nassaucountyfl.com and in the body of such request you must state your email, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We do not need any other information from you to withdraw consent. The consequences of your withdrawing consent for online documents will be that transactions may take a longer time to process.

Required hardware and software
