AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 74-33 ZONING ORDINANCE, AMENDING ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 15; PROVIDING FOR THE CORRECTION OF A SCRIVENER ERROR WHICH OCCURRED AT THE TIME OF THE ADOPTION OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA having received a recommendation from the NASSAU COUNTY ZONING BOARD to amend Article VIII, Section 15 of Ordinance No. 74-33 to correct a scrivener error;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled that the following Section be corrected as follows:

ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 15

b. On-site signs are permitted in all commercial districts and off-site signs are a permitted use <u>in all commercial districts</u> except CN and COP. No sign erected after the adoption of the Zoning Ordinance in any commercial district shall project beyond the property line over by public street, right-of-way, walk or alley.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective upon being signed by the Chairman and Ex-Officio Chairman of the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners.
