WHEREAS, on the 28thday of September, 1983, the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida, did adopt ORDINANCE NO. 83-19, an Ordinance enacting and establishing a comprehensive zoning code for the unincorporated portion of Nassau County, Florida and

WHEREAS, W. T. Huntley and Louise L. Huntley the owner(s) of the real property described in this ordinance, has applied to the Board of County Commissioners for a rezoning and reclassification of that property from Commercial Neighborhood and Open Rural (CN&OR) to commercial Neighborhood (CN)

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Zoning Board, after due notice and public hearing has made its recommendations to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the above recommendations, the Commission finds that such rezoning is consistent with the overall comprehensive zoning ordinance and orderly development of the County of Nassau, Florida:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida:

SECTION 1: Property Rezoned: The real property described in Section 2 is rezoned and reclassified from Commercial Neighborhood & Open CN to Commercial Neighborhood (CN) as defined and classified under the OR) Zoning Ordinance, Nassau County, Florida.

SECTION 2: Owner and Description: The land rezoned by this ordinance is owned by W. T. Huntley and Louise L. Huntley and is described as follows:

SECTION 3: Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective upon being signed by the Chariman of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida.


