AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 86-1 WHICH REGULATES CONTRACTORS AND THE BUSINESS OF CONTRACTING; SAID AMENDMENT AMENDS SECTION III BY EXTENDING THE TIME PERIOD WITHIN WHICH INDIVIDUALS MAY RECEIVE A CERTIFICATION BY THE BOARD WITHOUT EXAMINATION.

WHEREAS, On the 22nd day of October, 1985, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 86-1 and

WHEREAS, The Nassau County Contractors Review Board, created by the Ordinance, has advised the County Commissioners that the time period set forth in Section III of said Ordinance is not of sufficient length.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. Section III of Ordinance 86-1 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION III. Grandfather Clause

A. Contractors, within thirty--(30)--days thirteen (13) months of the date of the adoption of this ordinance, shall apply to the Nassau County Review Board for certification. Upon appearing before said Board and with the concurrence of said Board, such person holding a valid State Registration or Certification in applicable trades or a County occupational license for trades not regulated by the State in the business for which a certification is being requested, shall be forthwith granted a certificate by the Board without examination except as otherwise provided by State Law.

B. Such certificates shall be recorded with the Nassau County Chief Building Inspector within thirty-(30)-days thirteen (13) months after it shall have been granted by the Board.
