ORDINANCE 89 - 17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 87-17, ESTABLISHED IMPACT FEES WHICH FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT, EDUCATION, ROAD SYSTEMS, FIRE, RESCUE. PARKS AND RECREATION, AND ADMINISTRATION ON NEW CONSTRUCTION WITHIN NASSAU COUNTY; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 2, APPLICABILITY, CREATING AN EXEMPTION FOR NASSAU COUNTY RESIDENTS WHEN A STRUCTURE IS MOVED TO A VACANT PARCEL OF LAND; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has determined that Ordinance 87-17 should be amended; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has held workshops and conducted a public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this <u>23rd</u> day of <u>May</u>, 1989, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY

9. A building or structure, including a mobile home, to be occupied by a Nassau County resident, wherein the Nassau County resident has moved from a prior parcel of land in Nassau County, on which was located a residential building or structure, including a mobile home, and that parcel of land does not now have a residential building, structure, or mobile home on it. The resident must be able to demonstrate through evidence and/or an affidavit his residency and the requirements of this Paragraph.

2. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE:</u> This Ordinance shall become effective pursuant to law.
