ORDINANCE 90 - 16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 88-20, AS AMENDED; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 7, SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS, PARAGRAPH 7.3; CREATING A NEW SECTION 15, TIPPING FEES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it necessary to amend Ordinance 88-20, as further amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 20^{n} day of $\mu \nu \rho \nu s c$, 1990, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 88-20, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

1. SECTION 7. SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

7.3 The following special assessments are hereby imposed:

(a) For each dwelling unit on a parcel: \$100.00, and said \$100.00 special assessment shall commence on October 1, 1989, and ending September 30, 1990, and the benefits to be conferred by the MSBU are deemed to be in excess of the cost hereof. The annual assessment shall be October 1 to September 30 of each year thereafter.

-----(b)--Commercial-shall-be-assessed-to-the-haulers-based-upon: -----(1)--Commercial:--The-haulers-presently-operating-within-the County:--City-of-Fernandina-Beach,-Nassau-Sanitation,-Stokes-and Nassau-Improvements-shall-pay-to-the-County-based-upon-a-thirty (\$30.00)-per-ton-charge,-an-amount-each-month-for-the-commercial

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material-placed-in-the-landfill---The-vehicles-will-be-weighed-on the-scales-at-the-landfill-and-the-monthly-bills-shall-be-paid-by the-haulers-within-thirty-(30)-days-of-their-receipt-

-----(2)----Each---hauler---shall---designate---trucks---for---the transportation-of-commercial-garbage-only-and-provide-the-Board with-a-complete-notarized-list-of-their-commercial-accounts.

(3)-band-owners-that-receive a special assessment-bill-from the--Tax--Collector--shall,--upon--presentation--of--a--notarized statement-from-their-particular-hauler-verifying-that-they-are serviced-as-a-commercial-account,-be-deleted-from-the-special assessment-rolls-for-dwelling-unit-parcels.

(4)--The-commercial-assessment-shall-commence-on-June-1; 1988;-and-continue-each-and-every-month-thereafter:

(c) Mobile home parks and travel trailer and recreational vehicle defined areas shall be assessed fifty <u>one hundred</u> dollars (50-00) <u>(\$100.00)</u> for each space-or--shall-pay--the-commercial hauler-if-it-utilizes-containers-and/or-dumpsters-as-defined-in Section-1(1).

2. SECTION 15. TIPPING FEES

15.1 There shall be a tipping fee payable for use of the County landfill facility. The fee schedule shall be as follows:

(a) Residential fee: \$15.00 per ton.

(b) Commercial and Industrial fee: \$45.00 per ton.

(c) Residential Refuse Fee: \$.25 per bag - up to thirty (30) gallon bag.

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3. <u>SECTION 16. REGULATIONS</u> The Board of County <u>Commissioners may promulgate rules and regulations governing the</u> <u>use of the designated landfill in Nassau County.</u> Said rules and <u>regulations shall be set forth in resolution form.</u> Said rules and regulations shall be conspicuously placed at the designated

landfill and provided to the landfill operator.

4. Effective date: This Ordinance shall be effective upon receipt in the Secretary of State's office.
