

ORDINANCE NO. 93 - 8
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 83-19
NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of September, 1983, the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida, did adopt Ordinance No. 83-19, an Ordinance enacting and establishing a comprehensive zoning code for the unincorporated portion of Nassau County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, **JACK and DELORIS THOMPSON**, owners of the real property described in this Ordinance has applied to the Board of County Commissioners for a rezoning and reclassification of the property from RESIDENTIAL, SINGLE FAMILY-1 (RS-1) to COMMERCIAL, GENERAL (CG).

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Zoning Board, after due notice and public hearing has made its recommendations to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the above recommendations, the Commission finds that such rezoning is consistent with the overall comprehensive zoning ordinance and orderly development of the County of Nassau, Florida, and the specific area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida:

SECTION 1: PROPERTY REZONED: The real property described in Section 2 is rezoned and reclassified from RESIDENTIAL, SINGLE FAMILY-1 (RS-1) to COMMERCIAL, GENERAL (CG) as defined and classified under the zoning Ordinance, Nassau County, Florida.

SECTION 2: OWNER AND DESCRIPTION: The land rezoned by this ordinance is owned by **JACK and DELORIS THOMPSON**, and is described as follows:

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective upon being signed by the Chairman of the Board of

County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida.






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EXHIBIT "A"

DESCRIPTION: LOT 9, THOMPSON'S SUBDIVISION

All that certain piece or parcel of lands described in Official Records Book 63, Page 438, Public Records of Nassau County, Florida, lying and being in the Frances Wood Donation, Section 42, Township 2 North, Range 25 East, Nassau County, Florida and being more particularly described as follows: Commence at the intersection of the East line of the Frances Wood Donation, aforementioned and the intersection of the North right-of-way of State Road 200 (having a 100 foot right-of-way); thence S 65°37'58" W, along said northerly right-of-way line, a distance of 1623.78 feet to a concrete monument and the Point of Beginning; thence continue S 65°37'58" W, along said right-of-way, a distance of 100.00 feet to an iron; thence N 24°22'02" W, a distance of 300.00 feet to an iron; thence N 65°37'58" E, a distance of 100.00 feet to a concrete monument; thence S 24°22'02" E, a distance of 300.00 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 0.689 acres, more or less.
