ORDINANCE 94 - 28

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 92-20, WHICH ESTABLISHED RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE GRANTING OF PERMITS FOR PUBLIC DISPLAY OF FIREWORKS; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION V. HOURS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, <u>Florida Statutes</u>, Section 791.02, provides authority to the Board of County Commissioners to adopt rules and regulations for the public display of fireworks; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been made aware of a need to amended Ordinance 92-20.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this <u>9th</u> day of May, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, Ordinance 92-20 is hereby amended as follows:

1. SECTION V. HOURS

It shall be unlawful to use or explode fireworks before 7:00 a.m. and after 10:00 p.m.<u>, unless approved by the Board of County</u> <u>Commissioners.</u> Said times shall not be applicable on National holidays.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
