ORDINANCE 94 - 38

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 81-6, AS AMENDED, WHICH ESTABLISHED EMERGENCY AND NON-EMERGENCY FEES FOR CALLS MADE WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF NASSAU COUNTY; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 3, ITEMIZED CHARGES, INCREASING THE FEES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it necessary to further amend Ordinance 81-6, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this <u>8th</u> day of August, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 81-6, as amended, be further amended as follows:

1. <u>SECTION 1. EMERGENCY RATES</u>

Emergency rescue service shall be provided for all citizens of Nassau County, Florida, based upon the following rates:

A. <u>Transport Rates</u>

(1) Any service call that required that the patient be transported, a charge shall be made to patient of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) two hundred seventy-five dollars (\$275.00) plus a milage fee which shall be three dollars (\$3.00) five and 50/100 Dollars (\$5.50) per mile.

2. <u>SECTION 3. ITEMIZED CHARGES</u>
