AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 2001-19, TO AND SUPPORT A DEVELOP COMBINED COUNTY AND CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICER GIS INFORMATION POLICY, TO PRESERVE DATA INTEGRITY, LIMIT NASSAU COUNTY'S LIABILITY, MINIMIZE THE COST OF CREATION, MAINTENANCE, USE, AND DISSEMINATION OF GIS DATA AND TECHNOLOGY, MAXIMIZE GIS DATA USE THROUGH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MECHANISMS FOR DISSEMINATION OF GEOGRAPHIC AND RELATED INFORMATION DEVELOPED AND MAINTAINED BY NASSAU COUNTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA'S PUBLIC RECORDS LAWS, PROVIDE THE MECHANISM FOR THE COPYRIGHT AND LICENSING OF GEOGRAPHIC AND RELATED INFORMATION, AND TO MAXIMIZE THE RETURNS THE ΤO PUBLIC INVESTMENT IN GIS TECHNOLOGY AND DATA, BY LEVERAGING THE BENEFITS OF TECHNOLOGY AND DATA THROUGH COST RECOVERY MECHANISMS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Nassau County has found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that Ordinance 2001-19 be rescinded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this <u>27th</u> day of January, 2003, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 2001-19, approved on May 21, 2001, shall be immediately rescinded.
