## ORDINANCE 2005 - 58

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 94-18, WHICH PROVIDED FOR THE INSTALLATION AND PLACEMENT OF FIRE HYDRANTS; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION IV. APPEAL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County to amend Ordinance 94-18.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this <u>25th</u> day of July, 2005, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 94-18 shall be amended as follows:

1. <u>IV. APPEAL</u>. The decision of the spacing of fire hydrants may be appealed to the Board of County Commissioners with<u>in</u> thirty (30) days of the <del>Public Safety</del> <del>Director</del> <u>Fire Chief</u> or his designee determining the spacing requirements. The Board should schedule the appeal at its next regularly scheduled meeting upon receipt of the appeal.

2. <u>V. EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the
