

ORDINANCE NO. 2005- 61
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 83-19
NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of September, 1983, the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida, did adopt Ordinance No. 83-19, an Ordinance enacting and establishing a Comprehensive Zoning Code for the unincorporated portion of Nassau County, Florida, and which Ordinance has been subsequently amended including Ordinance No. 97-19, adopted on the 28th day of July, 1997; and

WHEREAS, **C. DAVID and IRIS T. JACOBSEN**, the owners of the real property described in this Ordinance, has applied to the Board of County Commissioners for a rezoning and reclassification of the property from COMMERCIAL, GENERAL (CG) to RESIDENTIAL, SINGLE FAMILY 1 (RS-1); and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Planning and Zoning Board, after due notice and public hearing has made its recommendations to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the above recommendations, the Commission finds that such rezoning is consistent with the overall Comprehensive Land Use Plan and orderly development of the County of Nassau, Florida, and the specific area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida:

SECTION 1. PROPERTY REZONED: The real property described in Section 2 is rezoned and reclassified from COMMERCIAL, GENERAL

(CG) to RESIDENTIAL, SINGLE FAMILY 1 (RS-1) as defined and classified under the Zoning Ordinance, Nassau County, Florida.

SECTION 2: OWNER AND DESCRIPTION: The land rezoned by this Ordinance is owned by **C. DAVID and IRIS T. JACOBSEN**, and is described as follows:

See Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof by specific reference.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida.


