ORDINANCE 2006 - 62

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 2006-56, WHICH WAS ENACTED PURSUANT TO <u>FLORIDA</u> <u>STATUTES</u>, SECTION 125.65, PROHIBITING BURNING OF TRASH AND YARD DEBRIS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, on June 12, 2006, enacted Ordinance 2006-56, which banned outdoor burning pursuant to Florida Statutes, Section 252.38; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been informed by the Fire Chief that the drought index has dropped below 200, and, therefore, he recommends rescission of the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 10th day of July, 2006, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners, having received the Fire Chief's recommendation to rescind Ordinance 2006-56 based upon the drought index dropping below 200, and the Board of County Commissioners hereby rescinds Ordinance 2006-56.

2. This recession shall take effect on July 11, 2006.

3. Copies of this Ordinance shall be distributed to the Sheriff's Office, State attorney's Office, News-Leader, Florida Times-Union, television stations, Chambers of

Commerce, County bulletin boards, Florida Division of Forestry, Fire Chief, each Fire Station and Volunteer Fire Station, County website, and cable channels.
