## **ORDINANCE NO. 2018-14**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, CORRECTING A SCRIVENER ERROR IN ORDINANCE NO. 2018-13, REGARDING REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST QUADRANT OF THE INTERSECTION OF SR200/A1A AND I-95 ALONG SEMPER FI DRIVE FROM OPEN RURAL (OR) AND COMMERCIAL HIGHWAY TOURIST (CHT) TO RESIDENTIAL GENERAL-1 (RG-1); PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the sixth Whereas clause in Ordinance No. 2018-13 referenced a proposed Planned

Unit Development (PUD) amendment, and that reference is a scrivener error; and

WHEREAS, the property as set forth in the legal description exhibit of Ordinance No. 2018-13 is

not a PUD; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges the need to address the scrivener error and delete the

reference to the terms "the proposed PUD amendment"; and

WHEREAS, all other provisions of Ordinance No. 2018-13 are correct and remain in full force

and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

- 1. Finding that the reference in the sixth Whereas clause to the terms "the proposed PUD amendment" is a scrivener error and should be deleted.
- 2. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 2018-13 are correct and shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed with the office of the Department of State.
