ORDINANCE NO. 91 - 14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 90-19; WHICH REGULATES CONCESSIONS IN COUNTY-OWNED OFF-BEACH PROPERTY OR COUNTY CONTROLLED PROPERTY; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION VIII- INSURANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have found it necessary to amend Ordinance 90-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board has found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that it amend Ordinance 90-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this $_{15th}$ day of $_{July}$, 1991, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 90-19 be amended as follows:

1. SECTION VIII. INSURANCE

- (A) It shall be unlawful for any concessionaire that-rents moving-equipment-(such-as-jet-skis-or-motorized-vehicles-or-boats to operate a beach concession unless the concessionaire shall have first procured and filed with the County, a liability insurance policy or policies, or a duly executed certificate of insurance, the terms and conditions of which shall provide for the protection of all persons suffering injury, loss, or damage to the person, or to property, by reasons of the operation of any concession.
- (B) The insurance policy or certificate of insurance shall provide comprehensive general liability coverage in the amount of

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) and shall be executed by an insurance company or companies authorized to do business in the State of Florida and acceptable to the County.

2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
