## RESOLUTION 90 -88

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 83-25, WHICH SET FORTH REGULATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BEACH PERMIT STICKERS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 83-25; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution contained a provisions for the sale of beach permit stickers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this <u>10th</u> day of April, 1990, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Resolution 83-25 shall be amended as follows:

- 1. Section 7 shall be deleted.
- 2. A new Section 7 shall read: The Clerk's office and each retail outlet shall be entitled to collect, for the sale of each annual and daily permit, an amount up to one dollar (\$1.00) for each annual and daily permit. Said charge shall be a handling charge and shall be deducted from the amount set forth in Ordinance 83-11, as amended. No retail outlet shall charge an amount higher than the amount set forth in Ordinance 83-11, as amended. Any retail outlet charging more than the amount set forth in Ordinance 83-11, as

of selling said permits.
