## RESOLUTION NO. 99-89

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 83-25, AS AMENDED, WHICH SET FORTH REGULATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BEACH PERMIT STICKERS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 83-25; and

whereas, said Resolution provides that no permit fee is required for vehicle owners who are handicapped or disabled, pursuant to Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to amend said Resolution to allow those persons who have a Disabled Persons Parking Permit Placard to utilize this placard similar to a beach permit sticker in order to allow vehicular access onto the Nassau County beaches.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 12<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1999 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:

1. Section 10 shall be amended to read as follows: There shall be no permit fee required for vehicle owners who are handicapped or disabled, pursuant to Florida Statutes. Those vehicle owners who are handicapped or disabled, pursuant to Florida Statutes, may utilize their existing handicapped/disabled vehicle sticker Disabled Persons Parking Permit Placard issued by the

Tax Collector's Office as and for a beach permit sticker. Senior citizens age sixty-five (65) and older may obtain a beach permit sticker from the Office of the Clerk of Courts at no charge upon proof of age.
