RESOLUTION 2005 - 92

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY REGARDING MEMBERSHIP ON APPOINTED COMMITTEES AND BOARDS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it necessary and prudent to establish a policy regarding citizen membership on committees and boards appointed by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, limiting the number of committees and boards that an individual citizen may serve on allows more citizens to serve on County committees and boards, thereby providing greater citizen participation

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this <u>23rd</u> day of May, 2005, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that the following policy shall be established:

- 1. No individual citizen may simultaneously serve, as a Board appointee, on more than one committee or board created by the Board of County Commissioners at the same point in time.
- 2. Any appointee now serving simultaneously on more than one committee or board shall be asked to choose the committee or board that they desire to remain on, and said choice shall be made within ten (10) days of the effective

date of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners shall fill any vacancy created.

3. This policy shall become effective upon its execution by the Chairman.
