RESOLUTION NO. 93-149

RESOLUTION REDUCING COMMERCIAL TIPPING FEE AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, Ordinance 91-17 provides for the imposition of a commercial tipping fee and annual assessment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners intends to adopt a one-half cent sales tax to be utilized for the operation of the West Nassau landfill; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of the one-half cent sales tax the tipping fee can be reduced and the annual assessment reduced.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this <u>27th</u> day of <u>September</u>, 1993 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Ordinance
91-17, hereby adopts a commercial tipping fee in the amount of
Forty-five dollars (\$45.00) per ton.

2. No commercial hauler shall utilize the Nassau County lanfill without paying the current tipping fee or the Forty-five dollars (\$45.00) as of December 1, 1993.

3. The annual assessment of One Hundred dollars (\$100) shall be reduced to Fifty-nine dollars (\$59) effective October 1, 1993.
