A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A COMMERCIAL TIPPING FEE AND ADDRESSING THE CURRENT TIPPING FEES

WHEREAS, Ordinance 91-17 provides for the imposition of a commercial tipping fee; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 91-17 provides that said fee should be established by Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this $\underline{Q^{\mu}}$ day of November, 1992, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the same commercial tipping fee as set forth in Resolution 91-115, which is Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per ton.

2. No commercial hauler shall utilize the Nassau County Landfill without paying the tipping fee of the \$75.00 per ton.
