AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 90-19. REGULATING ATLANTIC BEACH AND NASSAU SOUND BEACH CONCESSIONS ON NASSAU COUNTY BEACHES WITHIN THE AREAS UNDER NASSAU COUNTY'S CONTROL AMELIA ISLAND; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING VI, CONCESSION FEE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, recognizes that the Atlantic beach areas and Nassau Sound area on Amelia Island are a recreation area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County adopted Ordinance 90-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board has found it necessary to amend Ordinance 90-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 11th day of May, 1992, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 90-19, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

1. SECTION VI. CONCESSION FEE

(A) <u>Concession Fee</u>. Each on-beach concessionaire shall pay to the County a minimum annual fee of <u>fifty dollars (\$50.00)</u> one <u>hundred dollars (\$100.00)</u> on or before October 1. Each off-beach concession shall pay to the County a minimum annual fee of \$50.00 one <u>hundred dollars (\$100.00)</u>. A late charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be imposed upon the minimum fee. Failure to remit the minimum fee on or before November 1 of each year shall result in automatic suspension of the authorization to operate until such time as the fee plus late charges have been received by

the County.

2. <u>SECTION XII. EFFECTIVE DATE</u>

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
