

ORDINANCE 94 - 25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 94-1, WHICH ESTABLISHED THE SOUTH AMELIA ISLAND SHORE STABILIZATION MUNICIPAL BENEFIT UNIT; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 4, GOVERNING BODY; ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board has found it necessary to amend Ordinance 94-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this $\frac{25\text{th}}{}$ day of April, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 94-1 shall be amended as follows:

1. SECTION 4 - GOVERNING BODY; ADVISORY BOARD

- (a) The BOCC shall be the governing body of the MSBU.
- There is hereby created an aAdvisory bBoard to the BOCC concerning the beach nourishment program on Amelia Island to be undertaken by the MSBU-(the "Advisory Board"). The Advisory Board shall be composed of two (2) seven (7) members of the BOCC representing commissioner districts including all or part of Amelia Island and five (5) individuals owning real property located within the boundaries of the MSBU. The Advisory Board shall adopt procedures by which it shall operate and it shall elect a chair and vice chair and such other officers as its deems necessary. Advisory Board members shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners on an annual basis and may be re-appointed. The appointment date shall be set by the Board of County Commissioners. No individual may serve two (2) consecutive terms as the chair or vice chair. All members of the Advisory Board shall serve without compensation. The Advisory Board shall review proposals for the

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being 2. filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
