

ORDINANCE NO. 98-37

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 73-22, AS AMENDED, WHICH ESTABLISHED A BUILDING CODE FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF NASSAU COUNTY; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 1. TO ADOPT THE 1997 EDITION OF THE SOUTHERN STANDARD CODE INCLUDING APPENDICES A, C, D, E, AND I AND DELETING APPENDICES B, F, G, AND H; AND ADOPTING THE ASSOCIATED SST 10-97, STANDARD FOR HURRICANE RESISTANT RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has found it necessary for the health and safety of the citizens of Nassau County to amend Ordinance No. 73-22, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 14th day of December, 1998, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 73-22, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

1. SECTION 1. SOUTHERN BUILDING CODE: The Southern Standard Building Code, and its Appendices A, C, D, E, and I, being particularly the ~~1994~~ 1997 edition as promulgated by the Southern Building Code Congress, International, Inc.. ~~save and except Section 108 (Board of Adjustment and Appeal) of said Code. The Board of County Commissioners shall act as the Board of Adjustment.~~ The ~~1994~~ 1997 edition is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set forth at length herein, and from the date on which this Ordinance shall take effect, the provisions therein shall be controlling in the construction, alteration, repair, equipment, use and occupancy, location, maintenance, removal and demolition of every building or structure or any appurtenances connected or attached to such buildings or structures within the jurisdiction of this County.

2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its being filed with the Secretary of State.


