

ORDINANCE 2004 - 59

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 74-34, AS AMENDED, KNOWN AS THE NASSAU COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 2003 the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County established the Nassau County Animal Control Oversight Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Animal Control Oversight Committee was charged with the responsibility of proposing changes to the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners to the provisions of Ordinance 74-34, as amended, known as the Nassau County Animal Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, since February, 2004, the Nassau County Animal Control Oversight Committee researched and analyzed Local, State and National entities' policies, processes and procedures on Animal Control and Care; and

WHEREAS, in 2004 the Nassau County Animal Control Oversight Committee used this research to develop a New Animal Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Animal Control Oversight Committee has held a series of public meetings on this New Animal Control Ordinance; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authorized that Ordinance 74-34 as amended, known as the Nassau County Animal Control Ordinance, should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 13th day of December 2004, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


1. Ordinance 74-34, as amended, known as the Nassau County Animal Control Ordinance, shall hereby be repealed in its entirety.

2. This ordinance shall become effective upon being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.


