ORDINANCE 2005 - 35

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 74-32; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION ONE, MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County Florida is authorized to set maximum and minimum speed zones upon county roads, under Section 316.182(2) of the Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of public safety and welfare that the maximum speed limit on public ocean beaches be ten (10) miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the Board, in Ordinance 2002-61, amended the vehicular speed for motor vehicles on public beaches from fifteen (15) miles per hour to ten (10) miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to have consistency in all its Ordinances related to speed limits for motor vehicles on all public ocean beaches;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 25th day of April 2005 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida:

1. SECTION ONE. MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT

There is hereby established a maximum speed limit for all motor vehicles, except authorized vehicles, upon all

public ocean beaches not within incorporated municipalities of $\frac{\text{fifteen (15)}}{\text{ten (10)}}$ ten (10) miles per hour.

2. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective upon it being filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
