AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2003–45, AS AMENDED; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 6. RATES FOR WATER SERVICES; SECTION 7. RATES FOR WASTEWATER SERVICES; EXHIBIT A. RATE RG AND MF -SCHEDULE: AMELIA ISLAND **AND** RESIDENTIAL, GENERAL MULTI-FAMILY MASTER **METER** SERVICES. **EXHIBIT** В. SCHEDULE: AMELIA ISLAND – PF - PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE; EXHIBIT C. WHEREAS, Nassau County Ordinance No. 2003-45, as amended, which established rules, regulations and rates to be imposed by Nassau-Amelia Utilities for use of water and sewer services, was amended by Ordinance No. 2006-45 on April 10, 2006, to implement a fourteen percent (14%) increase in water and wastewater rates to offset substantial increases in operating and maintenance costs and capital improvements projects for Nassau-Amelia Utilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has contracted with the firm of Post Buckley, Schuh, and Jernigan, Inc., (hereinafter "the engineering firm") to perform a ten year Master Plan and Utilities Rate Study for the Nassau-Amelia Utilities; and

WHEREAS, the engineering firm has presented to the county a Fiscal Year 2007 Utility Rate Study and its projection for a ten-year plan, Water and Wastewater System Financial Management Program Summary, and Updated Service Availability and Miscellaneous Service Charges including replacement rates and charges Exhibits, as prepared in consultation with the engineering firm and its sub-consultant, Burton and Associates; and

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been made for a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in water and wastewater rates to help offset inflationary increases in operating costs, maintenance, and capital improvements projects for Nassau Amelia Utilities; and

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been made to update plant capacity and main extension charges for water and wastewater service resulting in a combined increase in water fees of 14.3% and a combined increase in wastewater fees of 13.1% to help offset increases in capital improvement costs; and

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been made to combine plant capacity and main extension charges for water and wastewater into a water impact fee and wastewater impact fee respectively, consistent with other public utilities; and

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been made to update all Service Availability and Miscellaneous Service Charges to reflect Nassau-Amelia Utilities costs (excluding AFPI charges); and

WHEREAS, customers of Nassau-Amelia Utilities were notified of the proposed rate increase and the reasons for said increase. The notice of proposed rate increase also indicated the date, time and location of the Board's public hearing for the proposed rate increase; and

WHEREAS, the Board has found it necessary to further amend Ordinance No. 2003-45.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this <u>13th</u> day of August, 2007, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance No. 2003-45, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

SECTION 6. Rates for Water Services.

The rates for the System for water services ("Water Services") relating to residential, general and multi-family master meter services, as set forth on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, are hereby established.

The rates for the System for Water Services relating to private fire protection services, as set forth on Exhibit "B" attached hereto, are hereby established.

The service availability charges for Water Services, as set forth on Exhibit "C" attached hereto, are hereby established.

The miscellaneous service charges for Water Services, as set forth on Exhibit "D" attached hereto, are hereby established.

Any base rate charges on an account terminated during the first ten (10) days of any given month, shall be prorated to the date the service is terminated. All accounts continuing beyond the tenth (10th) day shall pay the full monthly base charge.

The rates for the System for Water Services shall be increased by two and one-half (2 ½) percent over the rates in effect on October 1 of each year, unless contrary action is taken by the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners. The rates increased shall be those shown on Exhibits "A" and "B". The revised schedule of rates shall be filed with the County Coordinator.

SECTION 7. Rates for Wastewater Services.

The rates for the System for wastewater services ("Wastewater Services") relating to residential, general and multi-family master meter services, as set forth on Exhibit "E" attached hereto, are hereby established.

The rates for the System for Wastewater Services relating to residential service, as set forth on Exhibit "F" attached hereto, are hereby established.

The rates for the System for Wastewater Services relating to residential wastewater only services, as set forth on Exhibit "G" attached hereto, are hereby established.

The rates for the System for Wastewater Services relating to effluent services, as set forth on Exhibit "H" attached hereto, are hereby established.

The service availability charges for the System for Wastewater Services, as set forth on Exhibit "I" attached hereto, are hereby established.

The miscellaneous services charges for the System for Wastewater Services, as set forth on Exhibit "J" attached hereto, are hereby established.

Any base rate charges on an account terminated during the first ten (10) days of any given month, shall be pro-rated to the date the service is terminated. All accounts continuing beyond the tenth (10th) day shall pay the full monthly base charge.

The rates for the System for Wastewater Services shall be increased by two and one-half (2 ½) percent over the rates in effect on October 1 of each year, unless contrary action is taken by the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners. The rates increased shall be those shown on Exhibits "E", "F", "G" and "H". The revised schedule of rates shall be filed with the County Coordinator.

All other fees and rates not set forth in the attached exhibits shall remain the same.

13. Effective Date.

This Ordinance is enacted on the 13th day of August, 2007, upon the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of County Commissioners and shall become effective pursuant to the effective dates set forth in the attached Exhibits.
