

ORDINANCE NO. 2022- 026

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-18, ARTICLE II, SECTION 23½-11, MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON THE ATLANTIC OCEAN BEACHES AND SECTION 23½-12, CAMPING ON THE BEACH, AMENDING THE DATES FOR ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR BEACH DRIVING AND BEACH CAMPING; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 2021-18 on September 13, 2021, providing restrictions for beach driving and camping on the beach in the unincorporated areas of Nassau County, specifically amending dates for establishing rules and regulations for beach driving and camping on the beach; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes it is in the best interests and welfare of the citizens of Nassau County that the beach regulations contained in Ordinance 2021-18 should remain in effect until such time as the Board of County Commissioners amend this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Article II, Section 23½-11, Motorized Vehicles on the Atlantic Ocean Beaches and Section 23½ - 12, Camping on the Beach, of the Nassau County Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

1. AMENDMENTS:

Section 23½ -11 – Motorized Vehicles on the Atlantic Ocean Beaches.

(f) No motorized vehicles shall be allowed on the Atlantic Ocean beaches between the hours of 9:01 p.m. and 6:59 a.m. ~~from May 1 of 2020 through October 31 of 2022. The board of county commissioners shall determine, at an advertised public hearing on or before October 31, 2022, the rates and regulations for beach driving from November 1 of each year through April 30 of each~~

(b) Beach camping on the Atlantic Ocean beaches in the unincorporated areas of Nassau County, ~~between November 1, 2020 and October 31, 2022~~ shall not be permitted or allowed. ~~The board of county commissioners shall determine, at an advertised public hearing on or before October 31, 2022, the rules and regulations for beach camping from November 1 of each year through April 30 of each year.~~ The portions of the beach controlled by Amelia Island State Park are subject to their rules and regulations.


This ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.






