KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Carl C. Johnson, for the sole consideration of the sum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$150.00) DOLLARS to me in hand paid by Nassau County, Florida, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby release and discharge, and by these presents do for myself, my heirs, personal representatives and assigns, release and forever discharge the said Nassau County, Florida, and all persons, firms, and corporations, including the State of Florida, acting by, through and for said County, from all claims or demands for the taking of sand or other materials from my lands located in Section 37, Township 2 North, Range 24 East, also known as the Bellamy Grant, in Nassau County, Florida, said sand or other materials having been located in or taken from a certain 1 1/2 acre track used as a borrow-pit used in the construction of the Drury's Ferry Road known as State Road Department job 7451-250, F. A. project no. S-297(1), and being borrow-pit no. 2.

It is specifically acknowledged and understood that permission for the taking of such sands or materials from said land was granted by me, said Carl C. Johnson, to said Nassau County before such taking was commenced and that this payment is in full compensation of said sand or material and for any other claims that I might have in this regard.


