

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE  
ROAD DEPARTMENT TO FURNISH RIGHT  
OF WAY MAP TO NASSAU COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has for many years attempted to evolve a plan which would eliminate the traffic hazard at a point on State Road 200 approximately one mile South of the City limits of Fernandina Beach, sometimes known as Five Points, and

WHEREAS, the State Road Department of Florida has made certain studies in the past in an attempt to help this Board solve this problem, and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that by eliminating the Fourteenth Street and Amelia Road intersection at Five Points, it would leave a normal four way intersection at Five Points, eliminating the hazard of these two entrances, and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to request the State Road Department to make a study of this problem and prepare a right-of-way map which would cause Fourteenth Street to intersect with Sadler Road at a point where Susan Drive (according to Plat Book 3, Page 35 of the Nassau County Public Records) intersects with Sadler Road and extend said Susan Drive Southerly through Sections 29 and 30, Township 3 North, Range 28 East, and through Sections 3 and 4, Township 2 North, Range 28 East, and through Lots 14, 15 and 16 of Ocean Breeze Farms (according to Plat Book 1, Page 11, of the Nassau County Public Records) to a dirt road now in existence, thence along said dirt road in a Westerly direction to State Road 105-A, and

WHEREAS, should a road be established as above set forth, it would relieve the present traffic along said State Road 105-A Northerly from the Airport to State Road 200.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in special meeting duly assembled, that the State Road Department of Florida be, and it is hereby requested, to prepare a right-of-way map along the route as set forth in the preamble hereto, the exact location thereof to be determined by the State Road Department of Florida, for the purpose of acquiring necessary right-of-way under the Secondary Road System.
