

RESOLUTION NO. 116

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE SPEED OF VEHICLES ON DURDEN ROAD IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that it is necessary and expedient that a limitation on the speed of vehicles traveling certain highways in Nassau County be enacted and

WHEREAS, it appears that that certain road known and designated as Durden Road, in the Blackrock vicinity of Nassau County is one of the areas wherein speed limitations should be immediately enacted.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, in Special meeting duly assembled that the Board does hereby declare said Durden Road to be an area in which only limited speed of vehicles should be enforced, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board hereby determines that a speed of 30 Miles Per Hour should be posted and enforced on said Durden Road and that a speed of 30 Miles Per Hour is hereby established as a maximum speed limit for vehicles operating on said road, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to immediately have necessary signs prepared and posted along said road, indicating the speed of vehicles as herein indicated.
