

RESOLUTION NO. 127

Upon motion of Commissioner Beville, seconded by Commissioner Fisher, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, the engineering and miscellaneous overhead charged annually by the Department of Transportation to the Secondary Road Funds of the counties has increased to such proportion that the counties can administer their secondary road funds at a greater savings to the counties,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County is certain that it can administer the entire secondary road funds accruing to Nassau County at a much lower cost than the Department of Transportation and secure more roads in a shorter period of time than is now possible with the Department of Transportation administering the said funds.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN REGULAR SESSION THIS 18TH DAY OF APRIL, 1973:

1. That the 1973 Legislature be requested and urged to amend the statutes to provide that the entire Secondary gas tax, with the exception of debt service requirements of bond issues, be distributed to the counties and that the counties be authorized to prepare construction plans and let contracts for the construction of secondary roads, provided the construction of such roads meets or exceeds Department of Transportation specifications.

2. That copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Legislative Delegation representing Nassau County, to State Association of County Commissioners and to the Board of County Commissioners of each county in the State.
