WHEREAS, the U. S. Government, many years back established jetties on the entrance of the St. Marys River for the purpose of improving the harbor entrance and


WHEREAS, it is believed that the said jetties are a major factor as a cause of the erosion on the North end of Amelia Island and



WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has provided Section 1-11 in the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1968, said Section being for the purpose of mitigating damages caused by the construction of Federal Projects and

WHEREAS, it is believed that the jetties have contributed or cause the erosion on the North end of Amelia Island

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, that the U. S. Corp of Engineers are hereby formally requested to begin a Section 1-11 study to determine what effect the jetties have had on contributing to the beach erosion on the North end of Amelia Island and to do all things within the Corps power to mitigate said damage to the beach if the Corps study finds the jetties have caused the erosion.
