

RESOLUTION NO. 141

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING  
MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT UPON  
PORTIONS OF THE JOHNSON  
LAKE ROAD IN NASSAU COUNTY,  
FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 317.233(2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after full and careful investigation and in conformity to criteria promulgated by the State Road Department, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum limit on the Johnson Lake Road be changed as follows: a maximum speed of thirty-five (35) miles per hour upon that portion of Johnson Lake Road just west of I-95 beginning at AIA and going to Johnson's Lake Community, and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits be posted in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed limit of the Johnson Lake Road be changed as follows: A maximum speed of thirty-five (35) miles per hour upon that portion of Johnson Lake Road just west of I-95 beginning at AIA and going to Johnson's Lake Community, and that the County Engineer is hereby directed to obtain clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits and to post such signs in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.
