GENERAL NEEDS STATEMENT

In accordance with procedural guidelines established by the State Department of Community Affairs, Nassau County is submitting the following inventory of community development problems:

A. Planning Problems

1. The need for a detailed proposed land use arrangement anticipating land use requirements 20 years hence.
2. The need for a Community Facilities - Circulation Plan identifying the level and variety of public services and facilities needed to support the population of Nassau County 20 years hence.
3. The need for more efficient, environmentally acceptable and economical means of accommodating water and sewer demands, (area-wide water and sewer plan outlining system with capacity of future growth).
4. The need to identify and control several adverse impacts upon the quality of the environment (air and water pollution).
5. The need to identify the county's housing problems and develop a work program aimed at their elimination or amelioration.

B. Management Problems

1. The need for an analysis of the efficiency and effectiveness of the present governmental structure as it attempts to meet the demands of the community.
2. The need for capital budget and public improvement program to more systematically identify, fund and develop public improvement projects for the county.


