

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM
SPEED LIMIT UPON WILSON NECK ROAD
IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 316.182(2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after full and careful investigation and in conformity to criteria promulgated by the State Road Department, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum limit on Wilson Neck Road be changed as follows: a maximum speed of forty-five (45) miles per hour, except as otherwise indicated, and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits be posted in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed limit of the Wilson Neck Road be changed as follows: a maximum speed of forty-five (45) miles per hour, except as otherwise indicated, and that the County Engineer is hereby directed to obtain clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits and to post such signs in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.
