

RESOLUTION OPPOSING LEGISLATION BANNING  
VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON THE BEACHES OF NASSAU COUNTY

77 - 150

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County to go on record opposing any legislation which may prohibit vehicular traffic on the beaches of the unincorporated areas of Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, under the particular home rule powers given to the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County under the constitution revisions of 1968, it is the province and purview of said Board of County Commissioners to legislate the use of those unincorporated areas of beach within Nassau County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners was made aware of proposed legislation by the Honorable Steve Pajcic, Representative, Duval County, Florida, from a letter by Ms. Sonja McEvoy, dated January 26, 1977, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, wishes to respond to this proposed legislation by Representative Steve Pajcic.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, go on record as being opposed to any legislation prohibiting vehicular traffic on the beaches of the unincorporated areas of Nassau County, and be it further resolved that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, do hereby forward a copy of this resolution

to Representative Steve Pajcic noting their particular feelings  
and stance on this issue.
