

R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO TRANSFER MONIES FROM THE 032
BOND FUND TO THE COUNTY SECONDARY ROAD FUND
PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has previously
financed the purchase of Right of Way for ALA, which qualifies
as an 032 Bond Project, with Secondary Gas Tax Revenue, to
the extent of \$874,000, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation sees economic
benefits in awarding three contracts simultaneously for the
total proposed construction work on SR-121, estimated at
\$450,000, and

WHEREAS, to accomplish these construction projects in
the immediate future, the Department of Transportation request
an interfund transfer of 032 bond monies to the Secondary Road
Fund program in the amount as needed, estimated to be \$260,000,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County
Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, duly assembled, that
the Department of Transportation is authorized to transfer funds
as needed from the proceeds of bond issue 032 to the Secondary
Road fund, understanding that the estimated amount of transfer
will be 260,000.
