

RESOLUTION # 78-24

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS
ON 14th STREET EXTENSION, NASSAU COUNTY FLA.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 317.233(2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, This Board, after full and careful investigation and upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum limits on 14th Street Extension running northerly from the intersection of Cunnette Street be established as follows: a maximum speed of ~~forty~~-five (45) miles per hour beginning at MP 0.00 and ending at MP 0.60 and then begin thirty (30) miles per hour through MP 1.00 then begin forty-five (45) through MP 1.55 then begin thirty-five (35) miles per hour and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits be posted in appropriate areas along said roads to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed limit on 14th Street Extension be established as follows: A maximum speed of forty-five (45) miles per hour beginning at MP 0.00 and ending at MP 0.60 and then begin thirty (30) miles per hour through MP 1.00 then begin forty-five (45) through MP 1.55 then begin thirty-five (35) miles per hour.
