

R E S O L U T I O N 78-31

WHEREAS, Chapter 78.158, Laws of Florida, became effective July 1, 1978, and

WHEREAS, under that new law, the Division of Forestry must have the concurrence of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County in order to be authorized to designate railroad right-of-way's as fire hazard areas, if the facts so dictate, and


WHEREAS, the County of Nassau is desirous to have the assistance of the Forestry Department under this new Law of Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY does hereby concur and authorize the Division of Forestry of the Department of Agriculture and Conservation Services to designate those railroad right-of-ways in this County which are known fire hazard areas and to invoke the other benefits to Nassau County under Chapter 78.158, Laws of Florida.
