

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners on April 9, 1980, had selected the firm of Farmand, Farmand and Farmand, Certified Public Accountants to audit the records of the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County Tax Collector, Nassau County Sheriff and the Nassau County Property Appraiser for the fiscal ended September 30, 1979, pursuant to the provisions of Senate Bill 18-C of the 1979 Special Legislative Session, and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Clerk of Circuit Court, on September 26, 1979, prior to the passage of Senate Bill 18-C of the 1979 Special Legislative Session, retained the services of Terry B. Farmand, C.P.A, to audit the records of the Nassau County Clerk of Circuit Court for the fiscal year ended September 30, 1979, and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners and the Nassau County Clerk of Circuit Court have paid the above-mentioned C.P.A's total audit costs, including expenses, of \$35,787.50 and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 18-C of the 1979 Special Legislative Session allows for reimbursement of such audit costs. Then

LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners be reimbursed from the State of Florida Department of Community Affairs, \$35,787.50, for total audit costs it incurred for the 1978-79 audits of all Nassau County Agencies pursuant to the provisions of Senate Bill 18-C of the 1979 Special Legislative Session.
