LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMPREHENSIVE  
PLANNING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA has recognized a need to provide for orderly growth and management as contemplated by the passage of the Florida local Government Comprehensive Planning Act, and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has recognized a need to assist local governments in meeting the requirements of the Act, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has charged the Department of Community Affairs with administering the Local Government Comprehensive Planning Assistance Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Department of Community Affairs is requested to include the application of Nassau County among those requesting financial assistance from the Local Government Comprehensive Planning Act Assistance Fund Program for the 1980-1981 program year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, does hereby offer commitment to comply with the appropriate and applicable state and local laws, rules and regulations for the administration of this Program, including but not limited to, necessary matching funds, funding only eligible planning activities, etc., which are more fully described in Chapter 9B-5, Florida Administrative Code.
