

RESOLUTION NO. 80-8

NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, herein called the "entitlement", has thoroughly considered available information from the Florida Council on Criminal Justice;

Therefore, it is RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, in meeting duly assembled in the City of Fernandina Beach, Florida, this 19th day of February, 1980, as follows:


1.) That the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA declares its intent to elect criminal justice entitlement status with the Florida Council on Criminal Justice in order to participate as an entitlement jurisdiction during the fiscal years(s) 1981-1983 as prescribed by the Justice System Improvement Act of 1979 (Fl. 96-157); and

2.) That JOHN F. CLAXTON, Chairman of the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA be authorized to file in behalf of the entitlement a comprehensive application in the form prescribed by the Florida Bureau of Criminal Justice Assistance for a criminal justice improvement grant; and

3.) That said JOHN F. CLAXTON is further authorized to furnish such information and take such action as may be necessary to enable the entitlement to qualify for said grant.
