

RESOLUTION NO. 82-24

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners recognize that the arts provide recognition to the ongoing struggle of our time.

WHEREAS, Lewis Watkins, Artist, and Robert A. Moffa, Composer, through their combined efforts of artistic skills and talents, have recognized these ongoing struggles and oppressions of people throughout the World, by recognizing a major event, at this time, the people of Poland, "Solidarity".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NASSAU COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The combined talents and skills of Lewis Watkins and Robert A. Moffa, with the first major project, a sculpture piece, "Crosses of Life", and Orchestral Suite, "Poland Today", will be dedicated at the Church of the Nativity in Brandon, Florida on September 18th, 1982 at 1:30 p.m., to solidarity and the struggle of the people of Poland.

Section 2. For the purpose of illustrating Nassau County's admiration, respect and compasssion for the people of Poland, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners therfore proclaim September 18th, 1982 as "Solidarity Day".
